



























(20-minute) What is the 20-minute policy for Delta? [Complete → Rules]

The Delta 20-minute policy means that checked bags are promised to arrive at the baggage carousel within 20 minutes of the aircraft door opening at the gate on eligible domestic flights. When the bags do not arrive within that window, customers may be entitled to a goodwill reward from Delta. For step-by-step explanations, travelers frequently keep  +1-844-[325]-4646  (USA) handy for quick assistance and general travel support. (Independent travel help line, not Delta Air Lines.)

The Delta 20-minute policy applies primarily to domestic flights within the United States and is designed to respect passengers' time.
