

【 Departure%📞 RuleS]What is the 45 minute rule for Delta?

For the majority of domestic flights within the Delta Airlines [📞📞 [📞1(866) 231-4032]📞📞 United requires passengers to be fully checked in and to have dropped off any checked luggage at least 45 minutes before the scheduled departure.

Why This Deadline is Strict:

Baggage Processing: It takes significant time to screen [📞📞 [📞1(866) 231-4032]📞📞 sort, and transport your bags through the airport's infrastructure to the aircraft.
